

EMERGENCY SPECIAL CITY COUNCIL MEETING

MINUTES – SEPTEMBER 14, 2021

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President Pro Tem Bailey called the Emergency Special Meeting of Whitehall City Council to order at 6:30 p.m. on Tuesday, September 14, 2021.

On roll call by the clerk, the following members of council were present:

Mr. Rodriguez moved to excuse the absent members and Ms. Conison seconded the motion. There was no discussion. On a roll call vote, all members responded in the affirmative and President Potter and Chairperson Kantor were excused.

RESOLUTION NO. 024-2021 (was read by title only by President Pro Tem Bailey)

DIRECTING THE SUBMISSION OF THE QUESTION OF APPROVING ORDINANCE NO. 46-2021 TO THE ELECTORS AT THE NOVEMBER 2, 2021 GENERAL ELECTION.
