After the license has been approved the following must be followed:

- 1 - No person shall solicit *except* between the hours of 10 a.m. to 7 p.m. from April through September and 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. from October through March. Peddling and soliciting is *prohibited* on Sundays and any legal holiday.
- 2 - All circulars, samples or other material shall be handed to an occupant of the property or left in a secure place on the premises.
- 3 - No canvasser, solicitor shall enter or attempt to enter the residence of any resident in the City without an express invitation from the occupant of the residence.
- 4 - No solicitor shall make any false, fraudulent, misleading or deceptive statement during the course of that person's canvassing, soliciting or peddling activity within the City.
- 5 - No solicitor shall harass, intimidate, coerce or threaten any individual to induce a sale.
- 6 - No solicitor shall engage or transact any type of business or solicitation other than that specified on the license application.
- 7 - At no time shall any solicitor or peddler obstruct any street, alley, public right-of-way, sidewalk or driveway.
- 8 - No person, while engaged in any soliciting, shall knock at the door or ring the bell of any home, dwelling, apartment, apartment building or other dwelling unit in the City upon which is displayed a notice which reads, "No Solicitors Allowed or No Trespassing," or which otherwise clearly purports to prohibit solicitors on the premises, unless such solicitor is, or has been invited upon the premises by the owner, lessee or occupant thereof.
